

3. How to take Paracetamol Capsules

Paracetamol 500mg Capsules (GSL)

Dosage instruction: Do not take more frequently than every 4 hours.

Do not take more than the recommended dose

If you take more Paracetamol Capsules than you should

Talk to a doctor at once if you take too much of this medicine, even if you feel well. This is because too much paracetamol can cause delayed, serious liver damage. If your symptoms continue or your headache becomes persistent, see your doctor.

If you forget to take Paracetamol Capsules If you forget to take Paracetamol Capsules If you forget to take your capsules(s), take the next dose as normal. Do not take a double next dose as normal. Do not take a double dose to make up for a forgotten dose. Remember to leave at least 4 hours between doses.

4. Possible side effects

Like all medicines, this medicine can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

A small number of people have had side effects. Very rare cases of serious skin reactions have been reported.

Stop taking the medicine and tell your doctor immediately if you experience: • Allergic reactions which may be severe such as skin rash and itching sometimes with swelling of the mouth or face or shortness of breath

Skin rash or peeling, or mouth ulcers Breathing problems. These are more likely if you have experienced them before when taking other painkillers such as ibuprofen and aspirin

Unexplained **bruising** or **bleeding** Nausea, sudden weight loss, loss of appetite and yellowing of the eyes and skin.

Reporting of side effects If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. You can also report side effects directly via
